# 2018 Outreach Summary





The Carpenter Cancer Center at Sumner Station is committed to meeting the needs of our community and demonstrates this dedication by providing free cancer screenings and educational opportunities when available. Over 7,000 people were reached at over 10 educational events, health fairs, luncheons and festivals where cancer information, pamphlets, flyers were provided to the public and SRMC employees. We held a skin cancer screening in September 2018. We had 24 people attend. 5 needing additional follow up with Dr. Reed, the physician doing the screening. From the 5 additional workup; 2 patients were diagnosed with skin cancer and had surgery to remove.
