Having a baby is a special experience. New parents, and even experienced ones, may find the addition of a new family member overwhelming. Our classes are designed to prepare you and your spouse or support person for what lies ahead and to answer your questions.

All childbirth classes are taught by a registered nurse who is certified by the International Childbirth Education Association (ICEA), and our breastfeeding classes are taught by our own certified lactation consultant.

Labor of Love

Our Labor of Love class prepares parents-to-be for labor, delivery and newborn care. You'll learn about the signs of labor, the normal progress of labor and birth, techniques for coping with pain, and how your partner can assist you during labor. We will also discuss admission procedures, interventions, complications, including C-sections, and information about choices available so mothers-to-be can make informed decisions. The Women's Center. We encourage our mothers-to-be and their spouse or support person to attend this class during the seventh or eighth month of pregnancy. This four-week class series begins on the first Monday of every month and takes place from 6:30 p.m.– 9 p.m.
